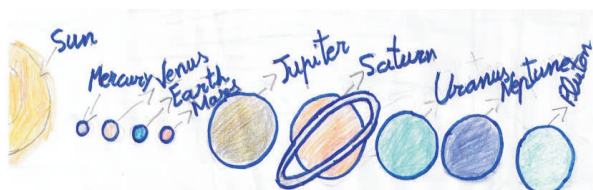
ROLE-PLAYS TO ENJOY LEARNING
