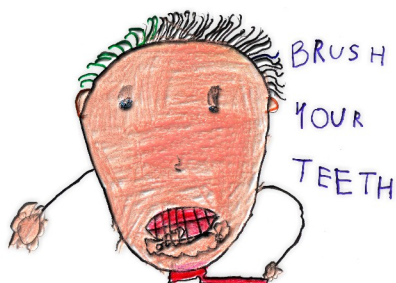


From September'12 to December'12

A peck of pickled peppers Peter Piper picked.

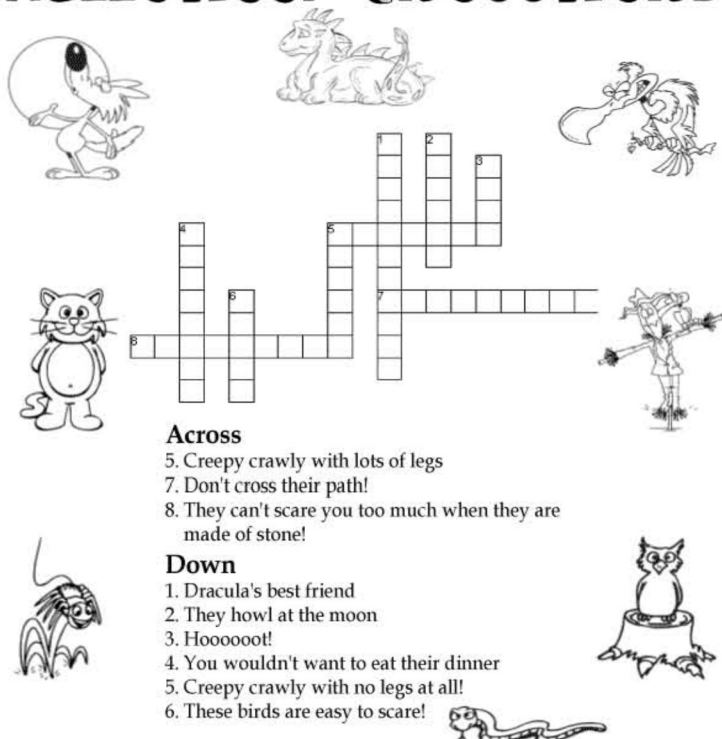
If Peter Piper picked a peck of pickled peppers,
